INSPECTION NOTES

On August 11, 2023, prevention officer spoke by phone, to an employer representative (the employer) regarding an incident notification. The *Workers Compensation Act* (the Act) and the Occupational Health and Safety Regulation (the Regulation) were used as a basis for compliance.

The following information was discussed:

I. INCIDENT INFORMATION

- date of incident: August 8, 2023
- a worker was near an electrical machine,
- the worker's left hand was passing near the insulation for the electrical machine when an electric arc occurred,
- the worker's hand received a 30 Kvolt electrical shock, and
- the worker sought medical assessment 2 days later d/t a sensation of numbness on left side of their body.

The employer stated that a preliminary incident investigation report was completed and a full incident investigation report is in progress. Additionally, the employer stated that the electrical machine was pulled from service until the full investigation is completed.

II. PLAN

The employer will upload the EIIR into the employer's portal for location #007 by September 8, 2023 and notify this officer that they have completed this task.

No orders are issued with this report. The officer may continue to review matters of compliance with the Act and Regulation in future inspections at this work site
